Executive Order 109791 of February 19, 2025


Ban of Musical Instruments Which Bear the Name, Image and/or Likeness of the President

By the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution and the laws of the United States of America, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1 . Policy. The instrument formerly known as “trumpet”, while a longstanding instrument with a respectable history, unlawfully bears the name of the President. Therefore any instrument currently bearing the name “trumpet” is now banned, effective immediately.

Sec. 2 . Any professional using the word “trumpet” in his/her official title is hereby enjoined from such use effective immediately. This includes, but is not limited to, titles such as: “Trumpet Player”; “Professor of Trumpet”; “Principal Trumpet”; “Trumpet Teacher”, etc.

Sec. 3 . Enforcement. The director of the National Endowment for the Arts is hereby ordered to enforce compliance with this Order among all public and private educational institutions and professional performing arts organizations within 30 days.
